

COUNCIL MINUTES

November 5, 2018

The City Council of the City of Knoxville, Iowa convened in special session Monday, November 5, 2018 at 5:00 pm. in the City Hall Council Chambers. Mayor Brian Hatch presided and the following Council Members were present: Megan Suhr, Cal Stephens, James Lane by phone and Dylan Morse. Staffs present were City Manager Aaron Adams, Assistant City Manager Heather Ussery, and Police Chief Dan Losada.

The meeting was a joint meeting with the Marion County Board of Supervisors. Marion County roll called, all board of supervisors were present. City Manager Aaron Adams updated council and the listening audience on the current process that the General Services Administration is in in regards to the VA campus. Board of Supervisor, Mark Raymie discussed the county's role in the purchase and demolition of the campus. Council member James Lane requested an amendment to item three of the memorandum of understanding in regards to the demolition of all buildings. Lane requested it be amended to demolition of all necessary structures. Council and Supervisors agreed on the amendment. Adams stated the federal government is working with the State Historic Preservation Office in gaining approval of the demolition of all structures.
